Bridget's story September 2022

Service name: MSK

Main purpose of service: The MSK (Musculoskeletal) service provides assessment and treatment of patients with complex musculoskeletal conditions - these usually affect the joints, muscles, bones and soft tissue. The team includes GP's with a specialist interest in Musculoskeletal Medicine, Advanced Clinical Practitioners in Physiotherapy, and an Advanced Clinical Podiatrist. An



Advanced Clinical Practitioner (or ACP) is a highly specialised physiotherapist who can provide a range of interventions and investigations for complex non-surgical musculoskeletal conditions which include treatment, education and advice. **About the person:** Bridget is 87 years old and retired. She enjoys Pilates, going to the gym and spending time with her family.

Burning: Bridget was already attending the MSK service due to a 'Frozen Shoulder' when she started to experience a burning pain on the side of her thigh. "My GP had to refer me for my leg, which they did, and I saw Dr Jamie Buckle at MSK at Princess Royal. He did a nerve conduction test and confirmed I had a blocked nerve. It's called Meralgia Paraesthetica. It's very painful and very specific. Jamie told me about an operation to release the nerve, but I live on my own. If I was younger, I may have had the op, but I have osteoporosis too."

Injections: Bridget explains how the MSK team support her. "I go every 3-4 months for a steroid injection in my groin. It has to be spot on! My GP has to re refer me, as I can only have 3 injections for each referral. It's instant relief. The burning stops. Then it's better for 2-3 months. I can sleep. I can walk better. Then it starts to hurt again, the burning starts again. I know it won't ever get better." Bridget feels that between her GP and the MSK team, her painful symptoms are managed well. "I can get pain killers from my GP, but they can't do the injections in the groin like they can at the MSK Clinic. I can't speak more highly about the clinic. It's been wonderful. When I go there, I think 'YES!'" Bridget has high praise for the team. "With Jamie, I never feel like I'm wasting his time. It's wonderful when someone understands the body's systems. We have a laugh too!" She continues, "I've seen Carl too. He's wonderful. He really knows his business. Carl is spot on!"
