


4. Look where she's hidden his cars! In her cot.

- Cars in cot




5. I don't know how she got the bricks on top of the cupboard. She must have thrown them up. Do you think Teddy can reach them?

- Boat in garden









- 7. And she's hidden his book in the drawer.

 - Spaceship in bath




