About the Treatment Room Clinic

Wound care and vitamin B12 injections are delivered at our Treatment Room Clinic, which is run by a registered nurse and healthcare assistant.

What You Will be Expected to Do:

Support the Treatment Room Clinic team by:

- Meeting and greeting patients on arrival and checking them off a clinic list
- Guiding patients to the waiting area and back out after their consultation, ensuring the department door is properly closed
- Signposting patients to the toilets and ensuring they are accessible by a ramp (when required)
- Helping and encouraging patients to complete a feedback survey after their appointment
- Monitoring the waiting area to make sure it is kept clean and tidy

You will also need to be available to signpost and/or accompany patients and visitors to other departments within the Princess Royal Health Centre if they are lost.

The Difference You Will Make:

You will make appointments more pleasant for patients by welcoming them on arrival and guiding them to waiting areas. You will also help the Treatment Room Clinic team collect valuable feedback.

- Confident and comfortable communicating with patients (including patients whose first language is not English)
- Able to use initiative
- Non-discriminatory, non-judgemental, open-minded attitude
- Reliable and able to maintain confidentiality
