Resilience and Complicated Grief

The third in a series of 4 CPD accredited instructor-based study sessions, Child

Bereavement is facilitated by Seamus Nash, a Counsellor and Psychotherapist

with The Kirkwood's Counselling Team.

It is well known that repeated contact with patients who are dying or supporting bereaved relatives can and does affect professionals.

The concept of 'resilience' is an important aspect for all to consider when assisting individuals who have experienced emotional and psychological distress.

This study day examines this concept using theory, group work and case discussion.

The session also focusses on the theoretical and diagnostic aspects of complicated and prolonged grief. It is experiential in nature with opportunities for case discussion and skills work.

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



The programme consists of:


- Four study days across the year (3 of which will happen from May 2022—July 2022)




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
